Single Session Tickets for 2018 Big 12 Men’s Basketball Championship Tickets on Sale Today

KANSAS CITY, Mo. (March 5, 2018) – A limited number of single session tickets for the 2018 Phillips 66 Big 12 Men’s Basketball Championship will be on sale to the public starting at 1 pm CT on Monday, March 5. Tickets are available in both the lower level and upper level while supplies last. Seat location and session prices range from \$30-\$110. Orders are limited to eight tickets per session. The 2018 event marks the 17th time that Kansas City will host the Big 12 Men’s Basketball Championship - more than any other city. For the 10th consecutive championship at Sprint Center, Kansas City’s downtown arena, tickets have been made available for purchase to the public.
