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## Camp WIN to kick off on Monday

KANSAS CITY, MO (June 1, 2018) – WIN for KC will kick off the first of three sessions of Camp WIN on Monday, June 4. Currently in its 16th year, Camp WIN has been expanded to three sessions with over 800 campers to participate over the week-long sessions this summer. Session one will be held at Notre Dame de Sion High School and the second and new third session will be held at St. Teresa's Academy.

As part of this empowering event, girls will have the chance to explore several sports and fitness activities while learning the [Live Active](#) curriculum. Camp attendees will participate in 18 different activities including self-defense, lacrosse, golf, tennis, soccer and gymnastics. Additionally, the pillars of the Live Active program: respect, goal setting, determination and leadership, will help promote life lessons off the field.

Campers learn from 160 high school and middle school volunteers who lead by example as they mentor the girls throughout the week. Instructors, who assist in teaching the different sports and fitness activities, are volunteers from local colleges, universities, high schools, clubs and other professional organizations.

The first session of Camp WIN will take place Monday, June 4 through Thursday, June 7 from 9 a.m. – 4 p.m. at the Notre Dame de Sion High School Campus. The second session will be held Monday, June 18 through Thursday, June 21 from 9 a.m. – 4 p.m. at St. Teresa's Academy.

Campers will be participating daily with activities from 10 a.m. – 12 p.m. and 1:30-3:30 p.m. WIN for KC organizers and participants will be available for interviews.
